

## Forecast is being materialize

EZE 38:1 The word of the LORD came to me: <sup>2</sup> "Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal; prophesy against him <sup>3</sup> and say: `This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am against you, O Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal. <sup>4</sup> I will turn you around, put hooks in your jaws and bring you out with your whole army--your horses, your horsemen fully armed, and a great horde with large and small shields, all of them brandishing their swords. <sup>5</sup> Persia, Cush and Put will be with them, all with shields and helmets, <sup>6</sup> also Gomer with all its troops, and Beth Togarmah from the far north with all its troops--the many nations with you.

<sup>15</sup> You will come from your place in the far north, you and many nations with you, all of them riding on horses, a great horde, a mighty army. <sup>16</sup> You will advance against my people Israel like a cloud that covers the land. In days to come, O Gog, I will bring you against my land, so that the nations may know me when I show myself holy through you before their eyes.

<sup>6</sup> I will send fire on Magog and on those who live in safety in the coastlands, and they will know that I am the LORD.

Zachariah 12:3 On that day, when all the nations of the earth are gathered against her, I will make Jerusalem an immovable rock for all the nations. All who try to move it will injure themselves. <sup>4</sup> On that day I will strike every horse with panic and its rider with madness," declares the LORD. "I will keep a watchful eye over the house of Judah, but I will blind all the horses of the nations. <sup>5</sup> Then the leaders of Judah will say in their hearts, `The people of Jerusalem are strong, because the LORD Almighty is their God

ZEC 14:12 This is the plague with which the LORD will strike all the nations that fought against Jerusalem: Their flesh will rot while they are still standing on their feet, their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongues will rot in their mouths. <sup>13</sup> On that day men will be stricken by the LORD with great panic. Each man will seize the hand of another, and they will attack each other. <sup>14</sup> Judah too will fight at Jerusalem. The wealth of all the surrounding nations will be collected--great quantities of gold and silver and clothing. <sup>15</sup> A similar plague will strike the horses and mules, the camels and donkeys, and all the animals in those camps.

REV 9:13 The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice coming from the horns of the golden altar that is before God. <sup>14</sup> It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." <sup>15</sup> And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind. <sup>16</sup> The number of the mounted troops was two hundred million.
